Leaving the Scene of a Fatal Car Crash

Crime Stoppers and the Nassau County Police Department are seeking the public's help in finding the vehicle and driver who left the scene of a Fatal Car Crash that occurred in West Hempstead, New York.

On Friday, July 21, 2006 at approximately 4:05 P.M., Alexis D. Robles, 23 years old was riding a Sun Star motorized mini scooter on Harrison Ave., at Eagle Ave. W. Hempstead, when he was struck and killed by a Driver in a Toyota SUV. The vehicle continued eastbound on Eagle Ave. towards Lakeview without stopping to identify himself or render aid.

The Vehicle involved is a 2001 – 2002 Toyota Four Runner SUV. The vehicle is Maroon or Red in color and should have substantial damage to the left front and drivers side of the vehicle.
